#### Video 1: Happy House Sitters

**Francine**: I am the happiest homeless pensioner in Australia doing what I like when I like. **Voix off**: That's right Francine is a pensioner, she's homeless and she couldn't be happier. This out-of-work schoolteacher has found a smart, fun and, most importantly, a cheap way to see the world! The 61-year-old grandmother is a house-sitter.

Francine: I get to meet beautiful people, their precious dogs.

**Ruth Meyers:** Pensioners is in our service do get a little bit of holiday accommodation or do a bit of traveling.

**Voix off**: Francine joined Ruth Meyers website "Happy House Sitters" last year and she's been in demand ever since.

**Ruth Meyers:** They need to think carefully and be prepared to carry out the little duties that the home owner is asking them to do.

**Voix off**: So far, bubbly Francine has been to Calrossie, Mount Eliza, Rye, Hastings, Ballarat, she's currently in Brisbane, then it's on to Flowerdale in Tasmania before heading off to Atherton in North Queensland, a stint in a wildlife refuge in Finch Hatton gorge near Mackay is next. Back to Caulfield, and after that, on to Tetbury in the UK!

Francine: Lovely people

**Voix off**: Francine pays to be a member of the "Happy House sitters" website. She doesn't get paid by the home-owners, so her pension is not affected. The cost is limited: the airfare to get to the house she's sitting, petrol while she's there and food

Ruth Meyers: the house-sitter usually get themselves a police clearance

**Voix off**: it's cheap for the home-owners too: it costs them nothing other than the utilities. Compare that to putting a dog in a kennel for at least \$25 a day and to pay a house-sitter which can be hundreds of dollars

Woman: I think she's winning

### Francine: yes

**Voix off**: Francine tends to sit for people who own pets. At the moment, it's **Meatball**, the bullterrier who is her constant companion and he doesn't seem to be missing his owners in the slightest

Woman: You spoil them, don't you?

Francine: oh yes

**Voix off**: the folder album is full of furry and even feathered friends she's made along the way. She gets very attached to some

Francine: I did cry when I left Chester, that was very hard, a chocolate lab

Voix off: and with pets she says, she's never lonely, the homeowners get taken care too Francine: every time I go, I leave flower arrangement or a leaf arrangement, greenery Voix off: easy to see why she's in such demand

### Video 2 Trusted Housesitters

"One of the things about TrustedHousesitters that had been (sic) a nice benefit is being able to meet people from all over the world and really getting to know them."

"It combines my love of animals and my love of travel so it's a win-win for me, it's perfect."

"You can be in a flat in the city, you can be on a beach but you're in a home in kind of a unique situation and then the cost of it is zero."

"We're getting somebody who wants to care for our dog and they're getting a nice place to stay in the centre of Barcelona, it's a great system I mean it's really... I wish I'd thought of it."

"And I've had 3 brilliant housesits. One in the Swiss Alps, another one in London and the third one was in Paris."

"I don't want any money for doing it, I get enjoyment out of it. "

"If you can demonstrate that you're caring, and you're trustworthy, and obviously if you love pets as well, then simply register with the site, and once you create a profile you start to receive the latest housesits in your e-mail and if you like a housesit then you apply directly to that homeowner and then you basically continue the conversation with one another."

"Some people genuinely want to come and be with pets because they don't have their own and they want to spend time with animals; other people just want to come somewhere peaceful and quiet to work; the family we had staying just wanted to escape from all the Christmas chaos in England and just come somewhere quiet."

"We share a meal, we share a bottle of wine, we have a drink together, we feel welcome and it's a good exchange."

"As a solo traveller it can get quite lonely on the road so having a pet around for that companionship, especially a dog, is fantastic. People always talk to if you have a dog. So it's a great way to connect with people as well."

"Taking a walk in Central Park with a dog and feeling like a local and not like a tourist."

"The second time we had a 'trustedhousesitter' come she just happened to come right when our neighbourhood was having their neighbourhood festival - festival Mayor de Sarria. I was actually sort of sad to be leaving our neighbourhood. However, Caroline had the opportunity to absorb all of the festival happening in our neighbourhood and that was a great bonus - for her."

"For me it's a win-win: I get to see animals, places... But I just get to spend that time in the local community, the local environment, and everybody comes out happy."

"If anybody was considering being a sitter, yeah I think you'll thoroughly enjoy it, it's one of the most rewarding things that we've done."

    - *T1: see the world; V1: doing what I like when I like; smart, fun and cheap (way of traveling); V1: meet beautiful people, meet precious dogs*
    - Mention the qualities which would make you a good house-sitter.
      - V2 : trustworthy, caring, love dogs
      - *T1: able to keep the house safe, tidy and in good condition.*

Why I want to house sit :

- Explain why you would like to house and pet-sit.
  - V2: meet people from all over the world; escape noisy environment
    - *V2: live/feel like a local, spend time in the local community; people always talk to you when you have a dog*
    - *V2: be with pets because I don't have my own and I want to spend time with animals; companionship*
    - *V1: taking care of animals*

My experience / skills:

- Mention your experience with previous landlords and pet-owners, and send your references

  - V2: companionship (solo traveller, it can get quite lonely on the road, having a pet around, people always talk to if you have a dog, great way to connect with people); have time to really know the people you meet
  - *V2: meet people from around the world; feeling like a local*
- Show your interest for Sonja and Bill 's offer as well as for their dog.
  - T3: Location of the house (quiet street, close to shops), walking tracks
  - T2: let them know you've looked into transportation option
  - T3:14 year-old Belgian Shepherd called Neffie
- Demonstrate your skills and ability to care for their house and dog, referring to your past experience ;
  - T3: feed / cuddle / medication;
  - T3: Water the gardens, mow the lawn, maintain the pool
  - T2: References from previous landlords
  - V2: trustworthy, caring, love dogs
- Talk about your expectations. Make sure to include the questions you still have before ending your vocal with an appropriate message to the hosts.
  - *V1: doing what I like when I like; smart, fun and cheap (way of traveling); V1: meet beautiful people, meet precious dogs*
