Simulates a realistic situation related to current issues. The available documents enable the candidates to collect the information needed to confront their viewpoints and reach a compromise.


▶ The candidates must be able to interact and negotiate in everyday-like situations and professional contexts.

#### CLES C1 (4h20)

Simulates an expert presentation in a professional and/or academic context corresponding to a specific domain.

■The candidates must be able to enhance their foreign language competence
in social, academic and professional life at a proficient level.

Specific domains are: Arts and Human sciences; Engineering sciences; Life sciences and Biotechnology; Medical studies; Law, Economy and Management.
